
ENTRY

This cause originated in this court on the filing of a complaint for a writ of mandamus.

Accordingly, it is further ordered that Charles Tingler is prohibited from continuing or instituting legal proceedings in this court without first obtaining leave. Any request for leave shall be submitted to the clerk of this court by delivery service, by mail addressed to the Clerk of the Supreme Court, or in person for the court's review.
