* **JUDGMENT ENTRY**

Pursuant to the Jury's verdicts rendered on July 26, 2019 and this court's opinion of
December 26, 2019, the Court hereby enters judgment in favor of Defendant Dominic J.
Spinazze and against Plaintiff Bradley J. Delp, individually and as trustee of the Bradley J. Delp
Revocable Trust date January 8, 1992, as amended, as follows:

- Compensatory damages in the amount of Twenty Nine Thousand Four Hundred Thirty
Two Dollars (\$29,432.00);
- Punitive damages in the amount of Fifty Eight Thousand Eight Hundred Sixty Four
Dollars (\$58,864.00);
- Attorney fees and costs in the amount of One Hundred Ninety Three Thousand Two
Hundred Thirty Two Dollars and Two Cents (\$193,232.02).



Further, Bradley Delp is designated a Vexatious Litigator as follows. Delp shall not, without first obtaining leave from this court, 1) institute legal proceedings in the Court of Claims, or in a court of common pleas, municipal court, or county court without first seeking and obtaining leave of this court pursuant to R.C. 2323.52(F)(1); 2) institute legal proceedings in a court of appeals without first seeking and obtaining leave pursuant to R.C. 2323.52(F)(2); and 3) make any application, other than an application for leave to proceed under R.C. 2323.52(F)(1), in any legal proceedings instituted by Delp or another person in any of the courts listed above. This order applies to cases involving Delp, whether individually or in any other capacity, and irrespective of whether Delp is represented by counsel or not, and shall be effective as of the date of this order. Further, this order applies only to cases involving Spinazze (individually or in any capacity) as a party. Cases pending in any of the above-described courts as of the date of this order are exempted from these prohibitions.

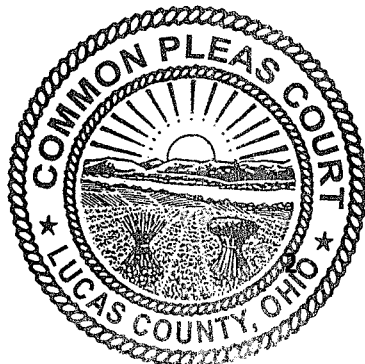
